Reappoint Solicitor, Tax Counsel/Delinquent Tax Collector

Director Honchar moved, seconded by Director O'Brien, to reappoint the Law Offices of Andrews and Price as solicitor(s), Tax Counsel and Delinquent Tax Collector of the District for a term of one (1) year beginning January 1, 2019, at a monthly retainer of \$600 and hourly rate of \$120 as presented. (Reorganization Item #1218-01 REVISED) By a voice vote, the motion carried 7-0.

Director Roussos thanked Mr. Andrews for his outstanding guidance and expertise, with all board member concurring.
