<u>Head Start and Pre-K Counts</u> programs provide preschool children ages three to five with quality, flexible programming, designed to reinforce and respond to the strengths and needs of each individual child and family.

<u>Early Head Start Services</u> are available to pregnant women and families with children from birth to three years of age. (Openings for Early Head Start are limited.)

Families must reside in Allegheny County and meet program guidelines to participate.
