SWEARING-IN OF RECENTLY ELECTED SCHOOL DIRECTORS:

♦ Board members opened nominations for election of temporary president.

Director Wilson nominated David Roussos as temporary president for the purpose of reorganization.

With no further nominations, Director Tassaro moved, seconded by Director Walkowiak to close the nominations. By a voice vote, the motion carried 9-0.

• Director Roussos, as temporary president, then took the Chair.
